Additional Information - Permits and Vehicle Emission Permit Thresholds

- Permit and vehicle emission discount review

The Council proposes to amend the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Off Street Parking Places) Order (“the off street order”) with regards to permits and the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order (“the on street order”) with regards to vehicle emission permits.

The modification to the Orders includes:

- Introduction of a new permit type

Proposal to introduce a new permit type (Ruby). Parking bays for this permit type will be in prime locations within the relevant car park and will be installed at the time each new permit is issued. This therefore is a dedicated parking bay to the permit holder and any other vehicle parked there will be subject to enforcement action. The permit cost is detailed in the below table.

This will help provide adequate off street parking provision for those that require regular dedicated parking.

- Removal of permits for Eldon Square MSCP and Spillers car park

It is proposed to remove Spillers Car Park and Eldon Square MSCP from car parks where we offer Season Ticket Permits (Gold, Emerald and Diamond). For Spillers Car Park, paying the day rate each day will be cheaper than paying the new price from 1 April, and for Eldon Square MSCP we want to ensure the car park is dedicated to short stay parking only. We are therefore recommending that existing permit holders at Eldon Square MSCP apply for permits at Eldon Garden MSCP.

- Removal of 6 month permits

It is proposed to remove the ability to purchase a 6 month permit as the virtual permit system does not allow for this. Permits can therefore be purchased on 4 week, 13 week or an annual basis.

- Resident, Business and Charity Permits – threshold for vehicle emission discount

It is proposed to lower the threshold for vehicles to be eligible for a discounted resident, business or charity permit based on vehicle emission, from 120g/km to 75g/km, in line with Ultra Low Emission Vehicles (ULEVs)

The changes to the discount criteria will support the Council's air quality objectives and further promote low emission vehicles across the city.
