- 2 Helping young people understand what careers are available here in the North East
- 3 Helping young people understand how to get there

Our events enable employers to have constructive conversations with employees of the future, providing the opportunity to break down barriers, link the curriculum to careers and take learning out of the classroom into the real-world of work.

- 1 Identify the events of interest
- 2 Send an expression of interest to info@ne1can.co.uk
- 3 Places will be allocated and confirmed back to the education provider depending on availability
- 4 All students U16 must be accompanied by a member of staff. All students 16+ are welcome to attend independently or with staff. In the case of individual attendance, names and emergency contact numbers must be provided to NE1 CAN in advance
- 5 Final details will be sent out to the education provider in advance of the event

All education providers wishing to engage with the programme will be required to sign an annual service level agreement.
