Re: Notifying closures on the Tyne Bridge

I would like to give you notice of overnight closures on the Tyne Bridge. The full closure is required to allow the next phase of scaffolding to be installed on the east footpath. This scaffolding will encapsulate the screen plates and parapets, similar to what is currently in place on the west footpath. Installation will take place during night shifts to minimise disruption to pedestrians and cyclists using the live route.

Once installation is complete, the footpath will remain open to both pedestrians and cyclists. Access will be maintained through the scaffold walkway, which will have restricted widths and head heights, requiring four weeks of, Monday-Friday, overnight closures from Monday 3rd November until Friday 28th November, from 8pm until 6am, with the bridge fully open to traffic from Saturday, 29th November, at 6 am.

Please allow yourself time to plan and utilise public transport where possible. We do have an open pedestrian and cyclist route available. More information on travel advice and journey planning can be found at the dedicated webpage.
