#### **Additional Information (1)**

The Proposed amendment to opening hours for Grainger Town and Dean Street Multi-Storey Car Parks has now been approved and will operate on a 24 hour basis on both Saturdays and Sundays and will begin from Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> November.

This will see a 50p per hour parking charge from 19:00

This will be a 6 month trial and if successful may be extended to other nights or Multi-Storey Car Parks

#### **Additional Information (2)**

Newcastle City Council are working to develop improvements to the **north bound bus route** between **the Forsyth Road junction on the Great North Road and Rotary Way** and invite you to **have your say** on these proposals.

The proposal is to install two new sections of bus lane to connect existing sections together to improve the reliability of buses and to assist access around the city. This will also improve safety for more vulnerable road users such as pedestrians with the addition of a signalised crossing on the B1318 near the entrance to High Gosforth Park.

A suite of proposals encompassing bus improvements and active travel in central Gosforth (from Little Moor to Regent's Centre) will compliment this scheme and will be the subject of a separate engagement exercise in the coming weeks.

The proposed **changes to the current layout** include:

- A new section of north bound bus lane on the Great North Road between Forsyth Road and the approach to Blue House Roundabout.
- A new section of north bound bus lane on the flyover from the Great North Road to the approach to the Rotary Way roundabout.
- Replacing the existing pedestrian refuge near the entrance to High Gosforth Park and the Racecourse with a signalised puffin crossing.
